

Assistance Programs

The Masonic Home of Missouri is dedicated to bettering the lives of Masonic families in need through financial and other assistance programs and strengthening communities throughout the state.



Financial Assistance Programs

Long-Term Financial Assistance

A program that helps qualifying senior members remain in their homes or independent or assisted living facility. This program can provide monthly assistance for recurrent bills, or one time payments for expenses such as dental work, medical bills or hearing aids.

Short-Term Financial Assistance

A program that helps younger members of the fraternity when unforeseen financial hardships arise, such as a medical issue.

Children's Outreach

A program that provides help covering dental needs, adaptive equipment and other necessities for qualifying dependents of Missouri Master Masons and Missouri Ladies of the Order of the Eastern Star.

Recognition and Resources

Widows Recognition

This program recognizes Masonic widows and helps them keep ties to the organization after the passing of their husbands.

Veterans Recognition

This program honors Masonic veterans with a special ceremony and presentation of a Masonic flag, pin and certificate.

Financial Education

A program to support Masonic members and their families with organizing expenses and debts, budgeting and adjusting to changes in life circumstances through our accredited financial counselor.

Social Services

Provides guidance and resource options for Masonic families making difficult decisions.

Partnership Programs

Creating-A-Partnership

A financial assistance program that matches up to \$15,000 per Lodge or Chapter per year to help children in need. For every dollar the Lodge or Chapter provides, the Masonic Home will match it with two dollars. Projects funded by this program include paying past-due school lunch accounts, providing school supplies and new playground equipment.

Partnering to Honor

A financial assistance program that matches up to \$10,000 per Lodge or Chapter per year to help provide honor flights for veterans and care packages for active duty military members.

Masonic Family Cares

A financial assistance and volunteer coordination program that helps facilitate connections between Lodges and Chapters and the Masonic brothers and sisters in need in their communities.
